JOB ROLES & WORKPLACE TRAINING

First Year

In the first year, the student gains foundational knowledge about the facility management industry in the role of Junior Supervisor.



In the second year, the student advances to higher roles, such as Master Supervisor.



In the final year, the student progresses to roles equivalent to Facility Manager.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The admission process will include an entrance exam followed by a personal interview.





MODULAR STRUCTURE, AND ENTRY & EXIT OPTIONS

The Facility Management program follows the New Education Policy in higher education and allows students the flexibility of multiple entry and exit points. All B.Voc programs at BSDU are structured in this modular format, offering various entry and exit points with Certificate, Diploma and B.Voc Degrees.

Each of the six semesters is designed to carry 30 credits, adding up to a total of 180 credits upon completion of the B.Voc program. This modular approach provides students with the flexibility to progress through the program at their own pace and choose the level of qualification that best suits their academic and career aspirations.

Project Management



ADMISSION PROCESS

- Applications are invited online and offline.
- After receipt of the registration fee (INR 1000), the BSDU admissions office will review the application documents and select applicants for the entrance examination and an interview. Both can be conducted online or in person.
- Successful candidates will subsequently be called for counselling sessions, orientation, and document verification before the commencement of classes.

THE CAMPUS

BSDU, Jaipur is strategically situated at Mahindra World City, a multiproduct Special Economic Zone based on the concept of an 'Integrated Business City', that is home to prestigious firms like JCB, Mahindra, Infosys, ICICI Bank, RS India, TTK Healthcare, and Ball Corporation. It is located at just 45 min drive from both Jaipur International Airport and Railway Station.







SPORTS

BSDU believes in building an all-round personality including physical fitness for its students. It provides adequate outdoor and indoor sports facilities. These facilities include well-maintained volleyball and football grounds, carom, chess, table tennis, etc.



HOSTEL

BSDU offers hostel facility separately for boys and girls. It is a home away from home, equipped with indoor games facilities, common rooms, and a mess. Hot water is provided during winters. Twenty-four hour water and electricity supply is ensured. Strict security measures are taken to ensure safety of the students. The hostels have a resident warden. Mess facility has high-quality air-cooled dining room serving four meals everyday.

- Hostel charges include both hostel stay (Non-AC) and mess/dining charges.

CENTRAL LIBRARY

Central Library holds a hybrid collection of printed as well as electronic resources which include books, journals, databases, audiovisual aids, CDs/DVDs, e-books, e-journals, e-question papers, etc. Currently, it has a collection of 18,000 books, 900 CD/DVDs, Wall Chart in 13 Trades, Transparency Sheets in 18 Trades, DELNET Membership, EBSCO Engineering Database. Other Infrastructure includes DELNET, KOHA, DSpace software, and NPTEL Videos.
